Leprechauns usually take the form of aged, diminutive men who usually function as fairy shoemakers. Indeed, the name 'leprechaun' may have derived from the Irish leith bhrogan (shoemaker), although it has also been suggested that its origins may lie in luacharm'an (Irish for pygmy).
